PENTECOST SUNDAY

FOCUS: We each receive gifts from the Holy Spirit to share with others, for the greater good.

Today, as we celebrate the birthday of the Church with the coming of the Holy Spirit, we also reflect on the gifts that the Spirit gives to each of us. Let us pray to be able to recognize them, and ask for the grace to use them for the sake of the Kingdom.

LITURGY OF THE WORD: The first reading recounts the dramatic coming of the Holy Spirit to the disciples -- and their resulting ability *to speak in different tongues*. In his Letter to the Corinthians, Saint Paul writes that while there are *different kinds of spiritual gifts*, there is but *the same Spirit*, and *the same God*. In the Gospel, Jesus appears to the disciples in a locked room, gives them the Holy Spirit, and grants them the authority to forgive sins.
