### **FOURTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

**FOCUS:** Jesus' kingship is one of mercy with humility and compassion for all who struggle.

In the kingship of Jesus, we celebrate his humility and gentleness, and in a particular way, his

understanding of the blessings of children. His dominion is not one of power and control, but of a servant who lifts up the fallen and raises all who are burdened; he is gracious and merciful.

**LITURGY OF THE WORD:** Zechariah tells Jerusalem to rejoice, for their king shall *come to [them]...riding...on a colt*, proclaiming a message of peace to the nations. Saint Paul instructs the Romans that *whoever does not have the Spirit of Christ does not belong to him*. In the Gospel, Jesus gives praise to the Father for what he has revealed to the little ones.
